Program Overview

Many of our customers who are in a need of modular ramping only need it for a short period of time. The cost of purchasing the ramping system outright often does not make financial sense in that scenario. We have created a rental program to meet that short term need. However, if that short term need changes to more of a long term need and ultimately a purchase is necessary we allow for a significant portion of the monthly rental to go toward the purchase.

Modular ramps are built for the wear-and-tear of everyday use. Renting modular ramps allows safe and durable access to a client's home using a product that is designed with the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) in mind. A portable ramp is frequently substituted for these applications but the ramp used either is often too short or is inadequate for the application.

101 Mobility Rate for modular ramp rental

Although all ramp rental situations are unique, we make it simple and cost effective for most everyone who is in need.

For Residential Applications:

Take the number of feet needed X 100 X .10 = Residential rental

For Commercial Applications:

Take the number of feet needed X 100 X .20 = Commercial (ADA compliant) rental

- Only a 1 month minimum (industry standard is 3 months)
- One time installation and removal fee @ \$22 per linear ft.
- Rent to Own option. Rental cap (After 12 Months no more rent is collected and you own the ramp). If you choose to purchase during the agreed rental period you would contact a 101 Mobility Representative for payoff amount.
- Low security deposit. See agreement and sales representative for details.

GUIDELINES

ADA has established base guidelines for ramps to provide a safe access. For more information on ADA guidelines, visit www.ada.gov. 101 Mobility ramps are designed with the ADA in mind.

To make it simple in your own calculation for how much ramp you may need, keep this in mind: For every inch of rise you would need 1 ft of ramp. However, there may be slope of grade issues that may make it necessary for us to use more or less ramping.

ADA provides guidelines for safe access. In many cases it may be reasonable to operate out side of those guidelines. It really depends on the needs of the client and their equipment. For this reason it is very important to have an evaluation done by a certified 101 Mobility specialist. There is no reason to pay for more than you need.

What is Important in acquiring a ramp?

STRUCTURE

Not all ramps are created equal. Because they can be made of many different materials, including wood, steel, aluminum, and concrete, it's important to ensure that the ramp structure is appropriate for the application. It is also important to understand the durability of the ramp materials and the maintenance that may be required. To the right is a comparison on various ramp options.

Ramp Comparisons	Ease of Installation	Maintenance Level Required	Long-Term Disability	Ease of Removal and/or Relocation
Wood	Requires Considerable Time & Labor	Much Maintenance Required	Splinters, Cracks, Warps, & Fades	Impossible
Steel	Moderate Installation Time, But Very Heavy	Much Maintenance Required	Rusts	Difficult
Concrete	Requires Considerable Time & Labor	Little Maintenance Required	Very Durable	Impossible
101 Aluminum	Quick & Easy to Install	Little Maintenance Required	Very Durable	Very Simple
